5. Bid documents can be seen at and downloaded from the website www.nhidcl.com and <https://eprocure.gov.in> in Bid documents contain qualifying criteria for bidder, specification, bill of quantities, conditions and other details.
6. The site for the work is as mentioned in the RFP.
7. The original copy of payment proof of Bid security, Bid Document Fee, hard copy of Power of Attorney etc. in original can be submitted at the time of signing of Agreement as per MoRTH circular no. RW/NH-37010/4/2010-EAP (Printing) Vol IV dated 30.04.2020.

9. To participate in bidding process, bidders have to get (DSC) “Digital Signature Certificate” as per Information Technology Act-2000, to participate in online bidding. This certificate will be required for digitally signing the bid. Bidder can get above mentioned digital certificate from any approved vendors. The Bidder, who already possess valid (DSC) “Digital Signature Certificate” need not to procure new Digital Signature Certificate.
10. The bidders have to submit their bids online in electronic format with Digital Signature. The bid cannot be uploaded without Digital Signature. No proposal will be accepted in physical form.
11. Bids will be opened online as per time schedule mentioned at Sl. No. 20.
12. Before submission of online bids, bidder must ensure that scanned copy of all the necessary documents have been attached with bid.
13. The department will not be responsible for delay in online submission of bids whatsoever reasons may be.
14. All the required information for bid must be filled and submitted online.
15. Bidders should get ready with the scanned copies of cost of documents & Bid Security as specified in the tender documents. The original instruments in respect of cost of documents, Bid Security and relevant documents will be submitted to the Tenders Inviting Authority by Registered post/courier/by hand as per time schedule.

16. The details of cost of documents, Bid Security specified in the tender documents should be the same, as submitted online (Scanned copies) otherwise bid will not be accepted.
17. Bidders can contact the undersigned for any guidance for getting DSC or any other relevant details in respect of e-tendering process. Bidders should get ready with the scanned copies of cost of documents & Bid Security as specified in the tender documents. The original instruments in respect of cost of documents, Bid Security and relevant documents will be submitted to the Tenders Inviting Authority by Registered post/courier/by hand as per time schedule specified.

24. The following information is given for consideration by the prospective bidders:

The works shall be carried out as per site condition. The work may be required to be fully executed or partially executed as per site condition and direction of Engineer in charge and the project work will be foreclosed on fixing of appointed date of the upgradation work. Therefore, no claim whatsoever from any of the selected bidders on this account shall be entertained in this regard.

25. No Extension of Time shall be entertained in any circumstance.

26. Make in India- As per policy of Govt. of India to promote Make in India, the provisions vide order no. P-45021/2/2017-B. E-II dated 15.06.2017 on the subject “Public procurement (preference to Make in India)” shall be applicable to the extent possible.

27. The format of the performance BG will remain same as prescribed in the RFP. The e-Bank Guarantee shall be submitted. However, it is not possible to furnish the same in the form of e-Bank Guarantee, physical BG can be accepted as per MoRT&H circular no. NH-24028/14/2014-H(Vol-II) dated: 31.05.2023. 30. In the event that Phase-II works are not approved and/or are not taken up by NHIDCL, the withdrawal of works provisions shall not be applicable to Phase-II. The non-

approval or non-execution of Phase-II shall not be construed as withdrawal, reduction, or omission of scope, and the Contractor shall have no claim whatsoever on account of loss of profit, overheads, damages, compensation, or any other relief arising therefrom. Phase-I works shall continue to be executed strictly in accordance with the Contract provisions.

31. Since the subject work is proposed to be executed at the Risk and Cost of the existing EPC Contractor, the existing EPC Contractor, including its sister concerns, associate companies, affiliates, parent company, subsidiaries, or any entity having common ownership, control, or management, shall not be eligible to participate in the bidding process for the instant work, either individually or as a member of a Joint Venture / Consortium / Sub-contractor.
32. Further, if at any stage during the bidding process or during execution of the work, it is found or established that the existing EPC Contractor or any of its related entities is directly or indirectly involved in the execution of the work under Risk and Cost arrangement, the following actions shall be taken:
- (i) The bid shall be rejected / cancelled forthwith at any stage, without any liability to the Authority; and
 - (ii) The next eligible bidder (L2), subject to fulfillment of qualification criteria and acceptance of the quoted rates, shall be considered for award of the work; and
 - (iii) The Authority shall have the absolute right to take any further action as deemed appropriate under the Contract Agreement, RFP provisions, and applicable laws.
 - (iv) The decision of the Authority in this regard shall be final and binding on all bidders.
