1. The National Highways and Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. (hereinafter called “the Employer”) hereby invites Bids for Performance-Based Maintenance of Roads through e-tendering from experienced firms/organizations (hereinafter referred to as the “Bidders”) to bid for the works detailed in the table as mentioned below from the eligible bidders, excluding those firms who have been declared as Non-Performer by MoRTH/NHAI/NHIDCL/Any of State PWD/BRO or black listed/debarred for specified period by MoRTH/NHAI/NHIDCL/Any of State PWD/BRO.

**Note: The bidders shall also consider the following points before submitting their bids:**

**1.1 The Project work is located in the Jarawa Area 1 & 2, which is a tribal protected and restricted zone. Accordingly, the execution of works shall be subject to statutory restrictions on working hours, movement of men and machinery, and other regulatory controls as imposed by the competent authorities from time to time. The Contractor shall be deemed to have taken into account all such restrictions while quoting the bid and no claim on this account shall be entertained.**

**1.2** In the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, there are restrictions on quarrying operations and the availability of aggregates. Bidders are advised that local sources of aggregates may be limited or restricted by statutory and environmental regulations. Accordingly, the Bidders may procure construction materials, including aggregates, from the mainland or other permitted sources, at their own cost and risk. The Bid shall be quoted taking into account all such constraints, including transportation, handling, taxes, duties, and statutory compliances, and no additional claim on this account shall be admissible.
