Debarment Order

Subject: Debarment of M/s Jayshree International - M/s Emergent Technologies (JV) in NHIDCL/MORTH Projects for a period of 06 (six) Months.

It is brought to notice that that M/s Jayshree International - M/s Emergent Technologies (JV) was participated as bidder for the following work: -

Construction of Intermediate Lane Road with hard Shoulder from design Km 0+000 to Km 13.080(Total length:13.080 km) of Tuting -Zido section on NH-913 (Frontier Highway) in the State of Arunachal Pradesh on EPC Mode.

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Construction of Intermediate Lane of Pango to Jorging Road from Design Km 40+000 to Design Km 82+060 section of frontier Highway (NH-913) (Design Length: 42.06 Km, Package-II, Greenfield Alignment) in the State of Arunachal Pradesh on EPC mode.

2. During evaluation of bid documents submitted by the bidder, a complaint was received regarding the authenticity of a work experience certificate furnished by the JV partner, i.e., M/s Emergent Technologies in support of its technical qualification for both the above-mentioned projects. Therefore, the verification of work experience certificate was done by NHIDCL from issuing department/division and after verification, it was found that above work experience certificate is fake.

3. Accordingly, NHIDCL, vide Letter No. 4881 dated 05.02.2026 and Letter No. 4882 dated 05.02.2026, issued Show Cause Notices to M/s Jayshree International - M/s Emergent Technologies (JV) under Clauses 2.6.3, 4.1 and 4.3(b) of the RFP for submission of a fake work experience certificate in the bids submitted for the aforesaid projects.

4. WHEREAS, M/s Jayshree International and M/s Emergent Technologies (JV) submitted their replies on 18.02.2026 in response to the aforesaid Show Cause Notices, stating that the work experience certificate had been arranged through an external consultant engaged by M/s Emergent Technologies for assistance in tender preparation. They further stated that they became aware of the alleged falsity of the certificate only upon receipt of the Show Cause Notices.

5. The bidder requested that no punitive action be taken and submitted that the irregularity, if any, occurred due to the acts of the consultant and not because of any deliberate misconduct on its part. The replies submitted by the bidder were carefully examined; however, the same were found to be unsatisfactory.

AND WHEREAS, it has been established that a fake work experience certificate was submitted by the aforesaid bidder, namely M/s Jayshree International - M/s Emergent Technologies (JV), in support of its bids for both the subject projects.



6. WHEREAS, the submission of a fake work experience certificate by the bidder, through its JV partner M/s Emergent Technologies, constitutes a "Fraudulent Practice" as defined under Clause 4.3(b) of the Request for Proposal (RFP), and the Authority is entitled to take action under Clauses 4.1 and 2.6.3 of the RFP, including debarment of the bidder from participation in future NHIDCL/MoRTH projects.

7. A personal hearing was convened on 22.04.2026 at 11:00 AM at NHIDCL Headquarters before the Managing Director, NHIDCL, wherein the representatives of the bidder were afforded an opportunity to present their case.

8. After considering the submissions made during the personal hearing and upon examination of all facts, records, and material available on record, it has been conclusively established that the JV bidder submitted a fake work experience certificate, thereby committing a default under the provisions of the RFP and attracting the provisions relating to fraudulent practices.

9. Accordingly, in exercise of the powers vested in NHIDCL under Clauses 4.1 and 2.6.3 of the RFP, M/s Jayshree International - M/s Emergent Technologies (JV) is hereby debarred from participating in any NHIDCL/MoRTH project for a period of Six (06) Months with effect from the date of issuance of this Order.

10. This Order is issued with the approval of the Competent Authority.
