It is for general information to all concerned that M/s Zeliezhu & Sons, Dispur, Guwahati, Assam is hereby debarred for a period of 24 months from the date of issue of this notice after termination of contract One Time Improvement of Chandipur-Kanchanpur road of old NH-44A from Km 75.500 to Km 86.000 in the state of Tripura in the FY 2024-2025 on item rate & work order basis (2nd call) as per Clause 53.1 of the Contract Agreement causing the fundamental breaches under section 53.2 of the GCC of the Contract Agreement.

- 2. The firm M/s Zeliezhu & Sons, is debarred for a period of 24 months from participating in future projects to be undertaken by NHIDCL/MoRTH.
