
2. Further, the following additional provisions is also added in the subject project:

(i) **Damage to structures outside ROW:** - The Contractor shall adopt such work methodology ensuring that there shall be no damages to structures located outside RoW (either private or Govt. structures such as permanent or temporary building structures, sheds, utilities, trees, or other immovable structures) on account of construction and maintenance of the project highway. To avoid the above issues, it is clarified that **the cost of the repair/damaged structures, failing outside the ROW, should be borne by the Contractor, wherever damages are on account of the Contractor.** Further, it is Contractor's responsibility to retain videographic and photographic records of structures at vulnerable areas.

(ii) **Muck Dump Disposal:** The proposed project would involve a number of civil engineering activities leading to production of muck. The EPC Contractor shall have to present a Muck Disposal Plan according to the applicable rules and regulations of Government of Sikkim and Government of India. The excavated material available from excavation may be used by the EPC Contractor for the construction of project related works provided it meets the standards and specifications as defined in Schedule D and after payments of all applicable royalties and levies including taxes as per Government of Sikkim and Government of India rules and regulations. The EPC Contractor shall relocate and dump the excess material (at its own cost) at the suitable area identified by the Authority, in the way to avoid any negative impact on terrestrial and aquatic environment.

If additional area is required more than the suitable area identified by the Authority, the Contractor shall have to identify the excess suitable area in or around the project site, at its own cost, to relocate and dump the excess material in accordance with the applicable rules and regulations of Government of Sikkim and Government of India. For stabilization of dumped material engineering measures and/or other measures, retaining structures shall be proposed by the EPC Contractor (at its own cost), with individual plans and cross sections for all muck disposable area. The NGT Order dated 01.11.2018 shall be followed for disposal of muck.
