
In continuation of the above-mentioned RFP and with reference to Appendix to ITB, Clause 4.4 (B)(b)(i) and Appendix 1.7, it is hereby notified for information of all prospective bidders that the following clarification/modification shall be read as an integral and overriding part of the RFP document:

1. The provision and deployment of Mobile Hot Mix (Batch Mix) Plant of adequate capacity with electronic controls, to be deployed in the vicinity of the project stretch from Km 138.000 to Km 193.000, shall be mandatory for execution of the work.
2. Bidders shall submit documentary proof establishing assured ownership or assured availability of the Mobile Hot Mix Plant, which shall be in the form of ownership documents such as Registration Certificate (RC), purchase invoice, or entries in the firm's asset register, or alternatively, a valid lease agreement, hire agreement, or Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), duly notarized and valid for the entire contract period.
3. Submission of undertaking alone, including the undertaking as per Appendix 1.7, shall not be considered sufficient to establish compliance with the requirement of availability of the Mobile Hot Mix Plant. The undertaking shall be supported by the documentary evidence as stated above.
4. Failure to submit the required documentary proof along with the bid shall render the bid non-responsive and liable for rejection.
5. This corrigendum shall be deemed to form part of the RFP document and shall have overriding effect to the extent of inconsistency, if any. All other terms and conditions of the RFP shall remain unchanged.
