3rd Minutes of Meeting of Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) on 02.08.2021 to evaluate the Technical bids for CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR AUTHORITY'S ENGINEER FOR SUPERVISION OF:

Widening/Improvement to 4 (Four) Lane with Paved Shoulder of Daboka - Khatkhati stretch of NH-29 of Package 5 starting from Near Ganpath Gaur Gaon at Km 95+400 to Kwaram Taro village at Km 113+330 (Design KM 96+400 to Km 113+830) in the state of Assam on EPC mode- held at NHIDCL, New Delhi.

The RFP for the subject work was invited on 19.04.2021 with Bid due date 17.06.2021 and subsequently technical bids were opened on 18.06.2021.

2. The Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) earlier vide 2nd Minutes of Meeting dated 29.07.2021 had uploaded the Technical Result on NHIDCL website with proposal of opening of financial bids on 30.07.2021 at 11:30 hrs.

3. The committee received clarification from one of the prospective bidder, M/s K&J Projects Private Limited in Association with M/s JAIMAN Construction and Consultants LLP vide letter no. K&J/HYD/RO/Dab-Kha/2021-22/171, dated 30.07.2021 wherein the bidder has stated that since, MPRDC is not an implementing agency of MORTH and they neither entered into contract with MPRDC nor received LOA. The debarment order of MPRDC should not be taken into consideration. Further, the RO Jammu, NHAI has made the firm as Responsive referring the above stated clarifications for the project in J&K under NHDP Phase-II. Accordingly, the Committee decided to consider the representation submitted by M/s K&J Projects Private Limited in Association with M/s JAIMAN Construction and Consultants LLP on the same lines as already considered by NHAI.

4. The Committee however observed that Team Leader cum Sr. Highway Engineer proposed by M/s K&J Projects Private Limited in Association with M/s JAIMAN Construction and Consultants LLP was also proposed as Team Leader cum Senior Highway Engineer for another project in the state of Meghalaya with M/s URS Scott Wilson India Private Limited in association with M/s Krivam Consultant Private Limited, where the Consultant was declared as H-1. The matter was deliberated by the Committee decided that the score of the Team Leader cannot be considered for the instant project in accordance with clause 3.4(x)(f) of Section-2 of RFP. Therefore, the bidder is considered **Technically Non-Responsive**.
