RFP for 4-L of NH 37 from design Ch 0+000 on NH-8 near Karimganj to design Chainage 14+250 near Sutarkandi (Spur Connectivity to Indo/Bangladesh Border) Silchar-Churaibari Pkg-7 in the State of Assam on HAM Mode.

The Government of India had entrusted to the Authority the development, maintenance and management of National Highway No. 08 including the section from km 0+000 to km 14+250 (approx. 14.36 km). The Authority had resolved to augment the 4-L of NH 37 from design Ch 0+000 on NH-8 near Karimganj to design Chainage 14+250 near Sutarkandi (Spur Connectivity to Indo/Bangladesh Border) Silchar-Churaibari Pkg-7 in the State of Assam on HAM Mode (the “Project”) on design, build, operate and transfer (the “DBOT Annuity” or “Hybrid Annuity”) basis, and has decided to carry out the bidding process for selection of a private entity as the Bidder to whom the Project may be awarded. Bid submitted through any other mode shall not be entertained. However, Bid Security, Power of Attorney for signing of Bid, Power of Attorney for lead member of Consortium, if any, Joint Bidding Agreement for Consortium, if any, Integrity Pact, and experience certificates apostile at foreign origin, if any, and other documents required as per clause 2.11.2 of RFP shall be submitted physically in original by the Lowest Bidder before issuance of Letter of Award (LOA) by the Authority. However, while submitting Bid Security via Account Payee demand draft or Banker’s cheque, it is to be ensured by the Bidder that Account Payee demand draft or Banker’s cheque are submitted physically latest within 5-working days of the Bid Due Date (upto 11:00 hours). Please note that the Authority reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the BIDs without assigning any

reason whatsoever.
