However, equipment will be provided by its associate partner M/s National Engineering Office Pvt. Ltd. and M/s PNT Designs Pvt. Ltd. Accordingly marks for ownership of equipment have already been given on the basis of Equipment on MOU with Associate or on hiring. NSV-2, FWD-1 and RR-1.

Remarks:- The bidder claimed 19 marks in Criteria for assessment of experience in use of technology for road inspection. 

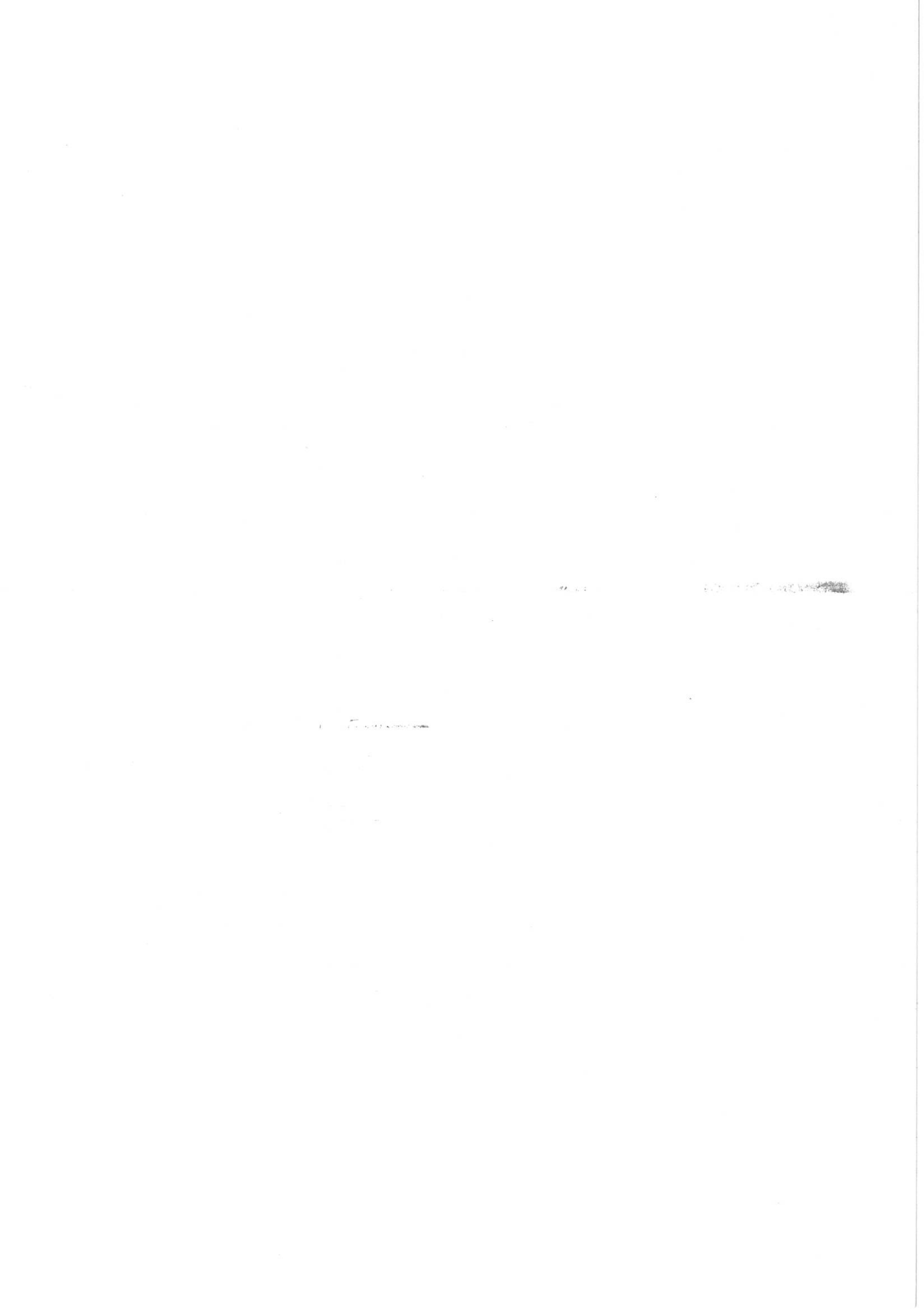

4. The revised above scores of the bidder couldn't be uploaded on the portal due to receipt of complaint against one of the bidder M/s Hexa Co.in Jv with M/s Sowil Ltd. and Ass. with M/s Casta Engineers Pvt. Ltd. through mail on dated 20/10/2020 stating the following:-

(i) Certificate submitted for completion/ experience outside India by the bidder is not attested by the Indian Embassy/Consulate/ High commission in the respect which is not appropriate for bidding in India.

(ii) Power of Attorney must be converted in English language and apostille or certified by their countries concern authority.

(iii) A foreign company must have registered office in India for bidding of such projects.

(iv) Power of Attorney is nor notarized in India not in origin.

5. It is mentioned that, the committee examined and considered the proposal of the bidder M/s Hexa Co.in Jv with M/s Sowil Ltd. and Ass. with M/s Casta Engineers Pvt. Ltd. based on the documents submitted in English version of Power of Attorney submitted by M/s Hexa Co. which was already notarized by the Judiciary of Islamic Republic of Iran, Karaj. However, M/s Hexa Co has intimated vide letter no. nil dated 27th Oct.2020, that they will submit necessary documents with proper attestation by the Indian Embassy in Iran as soon possible, hopefully it will not take more than 3 months and requested to consider the same.

6. Committee after due deliberation accepted the above request for further processing the evaluation subjected to that M/s Hexa Co will submit the above same documents after getting it duly attested/ apostille by the Indian embassy within 21 days from date of this Meeting i.e 27.10.2020.

7. In light of the above stated facts, Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) have deliberated in detail and recommended to upload the final technical scores on Infracon, NHIDCL website & CPP Portal and the Committee recommended to open Financial Bids with approval of the Competent Authority.
