Minutes of Meeting of Empowered Financial Evaluation Committee (EFEC) for "Selection of Consultants/ NGOs to assist in Implementation of Resettlement Action Plan for:

- (i) Widening and up gradation to 2-lane with paved shoulder configuration and geometric improvements from km 8.0 to km 380.0 on Aizawl-Tuipang section of NH-54 in the State of Mizoram; and
- (ii) Construction of 4 nos. of bypasses at Chhiathlang, Serchhip, Hnathial and Lawngtlai on this highway on Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) mode, with Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) loan assistance".

1. After having opened the financial bids of the technically qualified bidders, Empowered Financial Evaluation Committee (EFEC) met to evaluate the financial proposals on 15.05.2018. The details of Financial Proposals of the Technically Responsive bids of both firms and their combined score (Technical + Financial) with their respective ranks from H-1 and H-2 is tabulated below:

2. After combining the Technical and Financial Score, M/s CM Engineering and Solution emerged as the H-1 bidder. Member Secretary apprised the Committee that the cost of services will be met out of JICA Loan for which provision of about Rs 4.45 crore is for NH-54 and about Rs 1 Crore for NH-54 Bypasses.

3. The Committee observed that the amount quoted by H1 bidder is Rs 4.154 Crore and total length of the project is about (351.163+24.04), i.e. 375 km. Thus per km cost of H1 Bidder is about Rs 1.11 Lakh, which seems reasonable. The committee, thus, recommends that M/s CM Engineering and Solution may be invited for contract negotiations in accordance with Clause 6 of Instruction to NGOs Section 2 of RFP after the approval of Competent Authority.
