

Technical evaluation of the Five firms was carried out on 22.06.2021 (Minutes of Meeting is attached as Annexure-I). The scores of the firms in the technical evaluation were uploaded on the Infracon portal & NHIDCL website and the bidders were given an opportunity to offer their comments within 7 days.

2. One representation /comments was received from M/s CMEC Consulting Engineers Pvt. Ltd. in JV with AICONS Engineering Pvt. Ltd. & association with Nexgen Infra Solution vide letter dated 25.06.2020. The firm requested for enhancement of score from 19 to 20 in the experience in use of technology. Earlier, one mark was considered for hiring of MBIU equipment from Associate M/s Satra Infrastructure Management Service Pvt. Ltd as per RFP. However, MoRTH vide letter dated 06.01.2021 mentioned that “the marks for equipment is rationalized and full score be accorded for either of ownership or hire purchase or other option such as leasing as the intent of contract is to get the services of the Consultant for using the equipment for the given assignment”. Accordingly, the mark of said bidder in the experience in Mobile Bridge Inspection Unit (MBIU) is modified as under:

Having opened the Technical bids on 15.06.2021, Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) met on 22.06.2021 to evaluate the proposals as per the terms of RFP document.

2. Member Secretary apprised that:

- a) As per clause 4.1 of Section-2 of RFP, bidders are required to submit their Technical Proposal only through online mode i.e. via CPP portal and INFRACON portal and no separate hard copy was required to be submitted.
- b) 08 (Eight) firms submitted their bids on Infracon Portal and 06(Six) firms submitted their bids on CPP Portal. Details are as under:

3. The Committee noted that the Consultant had submitted their Technical Proposal on e-Procurement Portal i.e. on CPP Portal & INFRACON portal and the evaluation has been carried out based on the details submitted by bidders. The proposals were examined as per Section-2 (Letter of Invitation to Consultants) Data Sheet of RFP Document. Details of documents submitted by the bidders w.r.t. clause 4.1 (B) of RFP are attached at Annexure-I.

4. The Committee noted that as per clause 3.4 (x) (f) of Section-2 (Letter of Invitation to Consultants) of RFP Document, ***“If a CV score less than 75% marks, whatever marks it score will be carried forward for maximum 3 nos. key personnel for determining the total score of the firm. However, if the Key Personnel does not fulfill the minimum academic qualification (as mentioned at Enclosure-B of TOR of RFP), the overall score of his CV will be evaluated as zero. If the Key Personnel does not fulfill the minimum qualification related to experience (as mentioned at Enclosure-B of TOR of RFP), then zero marks will only be assigned for that sub***

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criteria, but the marks obtained by the CV of the Key Personnel will be carried forward for maximum 3 nos. key personnel for determining the total score of the firm. In case, a firm is H-1, then all such Key Personnel (whose CV scores less than 75% or who does not fulfill the minimum qualification) will have to be replaced by the firm before signing the contract. The reduction in remuneration of such replacements shall be 10% for each replacement. In case more than 3 CV scores less than 75% marks or Team leader cum Senior Pavement Engineer scores less than 75% marks, the proposal shall be considered non-responsive”.
