1	Annexure-III, Clause 8.1, Table-1, Sl. No.3 of RFP.	"A firm should have a 5 cr. average updated annual turnover for last three years (financial year) from consulting business". Whereelse, the work quantity is very small around 235 lane km. Scope of work to Avg. Annual Turnover ratio seems inproportionate, the same may be revised, as deemed fit.	Taken into consideration for review, a corrigendum will be issued clarifying the same
2	Annexure-II, Clause-7, of RFP.	As per present norms, the works should commence within 15 days from the date of signing of contract agreement. However, as Andaman & Nicobar Islands is a remote location due to which more then 14 days required to transport the vehicle from Delhi to Port Blair. It is requested that this timeline may be reviewed and atleast 30days may be allowed to start the work from the date of agreement.	Taken into consideration for review, a corrigendum will be issued clarifying the same
3	Annexure-IV, of RFP.	In view of remoteness of project location and very limited scope of work, i.e., 235 lane.km devided in seven packages, on NH-4, financial viability of "Package wise award of work for each package via QCBS methods" may be reviewed.	Taken into consideration for review, a corrigendum will be issued clarifying the same
4	Annexure-II, of RFP	Querry was raised during pre-bid meeting by the prospective bidder regarding the frequency of FWD, if its 6 months-wise or yearly basis.	Clause 2.3 of Terms of Reference(ToR) of RFP may be refered, wherein the frequency of conduct of FWD is elaborated. Further, it is clarified herewith that the frequency of surveys would not be restrictive to clause 2.2 and 2.3 of ToR of RFP and also shall comply with the directives of MoRTH, being circulated from time to time.
