- 2. Further, two complaints were received against M/s JK Electric Engineers Pvt. Ltd. & M/s MLAPLNP Associates stating that the firms have submitted fraudulent documents along with their bids. Hence, the documents submitted by the bidders M/s MM Brothers, M/s JK Electric Engineers Pvt. Ltd. & M/s MLAPLNP Associates were verified from the respective government departments.

Member Secretary of the committee apprised that based on the recommendation of Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) meeting held on 22.02.2021 certain clarifications were sought from the following bidders vide this office letters dated 22.02.2021 and email dated 24.02.2021 and they were asked to furnish their replies by 23.02.2021 and 25.02.2021 respectively. TEC noted that in respect of the documents required as per Clause 12.2.2 of ITB to ascertain their substantial responsiveness; the documents submitted in the proposals by the respective bidders are enclosed at **Annexure-I**.

- 2. The detailed clarifications received from the bidders are summed up as below:
 - A. M/s JK Electric Engineers Pvt. Ltd.: Bidder vide this office letter dt. 22.02.2021 and email dated 24.02.2021 was asked following clarification:
 - (i) One of the projects of Chenani-Nashri Tunnel has been claimed as similar work in your bid submission. You are requested to provide the completion certificate dated 29.11.2016 as mentioned in NHAI's certificate no. NHAI/PIU-Ramban /2019/11001/507 dated 12.12.2019 submitted in your bid alongwith LOA for the project. You are also requested to submit the cost breakup for laying/shifting of 33 KV, 11 KV and LT lines/cable for the project.

The reply submitted was deliberated by the Committee and was concluded that the bidder has claimed a similar work costing Rs. 40, 79,77,962/-. Based on the documents submitted by the bidder the total completion cost of Rs. 40.79 cr has been certified by the EPC contractor of the Chenani-Nashri Tunnel with completion date as 29.11.2016. The initial cost of work was Rs. 36.36 Cr and subsequently two additional work amounting to Rs. 1.20 Cr and Rs. 3.23 Cr. was issued vide separate letters dated 08.02.2016.

- B. M/s MLAPLNP Associates.: Bidder vide this office letter dt. 22.02.2021 and email dated 24.02.2021 was asked following clarifications:
 - (i) Two projects are claimed as similar work in your bid submission, you are requested to submit copy of JV agreement for both the projects. You are also requested to submit the cost breakup for laying/shifting of 33 KV, 11 KV and LT lines/cable for both the projects.
 - (ii) Email: you have submitted the Memorandum of Understanding instead of JV Agreement. Kindly submit the same. Also, in the completion certificate submitted by you, two different P.O nos. are mentioned one for supply and other for erection. Kindly submit copy of both the P.Os. You may also submit a soft copy of entire contract agreement to clear the issue.

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The reply submitted was deliberated by the Committee and was concluded by the committee that bidder has submitted the JV agreement in which share of lead partner (M/s MLAPLNP Associates) and other partner is 98 % and 2% respectively. Also it was found that two different LOAs have been issued to the bidder and two separate contracts were signed, one for supply and other for erection of both the projects claimed, however, LOI was issued combined for supply work and erection work and hence can be considered as single work.

- C. M/s H.P. Builders Pvt. Ltd.: Bidder vide this office letter dt. 22.02.2021 and email dated 24.02.2021 was asked following clarifications:
 - (i) One project has been claimed as similar work in your bid submission, you are requested to submit copy of completion certificate issued by the Authority alongwith the cost breakup for laying/shifting of 33 KV, 11 KV and LT lines/cable for the projects. The financial details given in CA certificate issued by M/s RAG & co. differs from the SA certificate issued by M/s Nitin Brij & Co. Kindly clarify.
 - (ii) Email: You are required to submit cost breakup for activities mentioned in the certificate issued to you on 04.05.2020. Also, in the completion certificate submitted by you, two different P.O nos. are mentioned one for supply and other for erection. Kindly submit copy of both the P.Os. You may also submit a soft copy of entire contract agreement to clear the issue.

The reply submitted was deliberated by the Committee and concluded that the Average annual turnover as per RFP format is Rs.10.13 Cr which is excluding the work executed in JV. However the bidder has also executed various works in JV, the average turnover of which is Rs. 21.02 Cr, Combinedly the turnover of the bidder including its work in JV is Rs. 31.15 Crore. It was also found that two different LOAs have been issued to the bidder and two separate contracts were signed, one for supply and other for erection of both the projects claimed, however, LOI was issued combined for supply work and erection work and hence can be considered as single work.

- D. M/s M.M. Brothers.: Bidder vide this office letter dt. 22.02.2021 and email dated 24.02.2021 was asked following clarifications:
 - (i) It is seen from your submission that two different LOAs have been issued for each of the project namely one LOA for supply contract and the other LOA for Erection contract. Kindly confirm the same. Also requested to submit the copies of JV agreement for above mentioned two projects alongwith the cost breakup.
 - (ii) Email: your clarification is contrary to the documents submitted. It has been seen from the documents submitted that only one LOI (not LOA) was issued for the project and two LOA has been issued for signing of supply contract and erection contract. Please clarify. Also the copy of complete LOA for Supply & Erection has not been submitted. Instead of submitting JV Agreement you have submitted undertaking by the JV Partners that too without Appendix-I. Kindly submit the same. You may also submit a soft copy of entire contract agreement to clear the issue.

The reply submitted was deliberated by the Committee and was concluded by the committee that two times bidder was asked to submit the JV agreement to ensure its share in JV inspite of this, bidder has not submitted the details in which JV share is mentioned for one of the project and hence the project cannot be considered. It was also found that two different LOAs have been issued to the bidder and two separate contracts were signed, one for supply and other for erection other claimed project, however, LOI was issued combined for supply work and erection work and hence can be considered as single work.

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3. TEC evaluated the technical bids as per provisions of the RFP based on the documents uploaded by bidders on e-procure portal and observed the following:
