4. Bidder must submit its Technical Bid and Financial bid at <https://eprocure.gov.in> at on or before 06.04.2020 upto 1200 hours IST. Bids received online shall be opened on 07.04.2020 (at 1200 hours IST).
5. Bid documents can be seen at and downloaded from the website www.nhidcl.com and <https://eprocure.gov.in> in Bid documents contain qualifying criteria for bidder, specification, bill of quantities, conditions and other details.
6. The site for the work is available.
7. Bidder shall submit the following documents.

 - ii) Demand Draft for cost of documents
 - iii) Demand Draft/Bank Guarantee for Bid Security
8. The interested bidder can download the NIT / bidding document from the website <https://eprocure.gov.in> & www.nhidcl.com
9. To participate in bidding process, bidders have to get (DSC) "Digital Signature Certificate" as per Information Technology Act-2000, to participate in online bidding. This certificate will be required for digitally signing the bid. Bidder can get above mentioned digital certificate from any approved vendors. The Bidder, who already possess valid (DSC)"Digital Signature Certificate" need not to procure new Digital Signature Certificate.
10. The bidders have to submit their bids online in electronic format with Digital Signature. The bid cannot be uploaded without Digital Signature. No proposal will be accepted in physical form.
11. Bids will be opened online as per time schedule mentioned at Sr. No. 19.
12. Before submission of online bids, bidder must ensure that scanned copy of all the necessary documents have been attached with bid.
13. The department will not be responsible for delay in online submission of bids whatsoever reasons may be.
14. All the required information for bid must be filled and submitted online.
15. Bidders should get ready with the scanned copies of cost of documents & Bid Security as specified in the tender documents. The original instruments in respect of cost of documents, Bid Security and relevant documents will be submitted to the Tenders Inviting Authority by Registered post/courier/by hand as per time schedule specified.
16. The details of cost of documents, Bid Security specified in the tender documents should be the same, as submitted online (Scanned copies) otherwise bid will not be accepted.

22. The following information is given for consideration by the prospective bidders:

At present, NHIDCL has been entrusted to maintain and develop this road. DPR work for widening/improvement of the road is under process. However, appointment of agency is required to carry out emergent repair works during monsoon period. Therefore, the bids invited by NHIDCL for Maintenance work and NITs are to carry out the maintenance of the National Highways which are being 01 (single) laned, in case the new Contractors are not appointed to carry out the maintenance work of existing highway and take necessary preventive action to ensure that the existing highway does not get damaged and remains in traffic worthy condition at all times. The maintenance works for which bids have been invited shall accordingly be carried out on as required basis by placing of work order (s) as per site condition.

Work order will be issued based on as and when required basis. The work may be required to be partially executed or may not be executed at all by NHIDCL. No claim whatsoever from any of the selected bidders on this account shall be entertained in this regard.
