

## National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd.

Minutes of Meeting of Empowered Financial Bid Evaluation Committee (EFEC)

Date: 19.07.2018 at NHIDCL (HQ)

Name of work: Up-gradation to 4-lane with Paved Shoulder of Jammu-Akhnoor road section of NH-144A from Ganesh Vihar (Km 6.000) to Hanuman chowk (Km 30.000) of 24 Km length in the state of Jammu and Kashmir to be executed on EPC basis. (Pkg.-III)

EFEC met to evaluate the single financial bid of M/s. S.P. Singla Construction Pvt. Ltd. ETEC noted that the single bidder has quoted the price which is 13.038 % above the amount put tender (i.e. Rs. 260.77 Crore). The Committee was apprised that the subject package is a part of 30 Km long Highway portion from Jammu to Akhnoor section of NH-144A. This package comprise of three sub-packages vis (i) Pkg-I from 4<sup>th</sup> Tawi Bridge (Km 0.000) to Km (0.800), (ii) Pkg.-II from Km 0.800 to Km 6.000 and the third package from km 6.000 to km 30.097.

- 2. The pkg.-II has already been awarded to the same firm at his quoted price which is 17.98% below the amount put to tender Pkg.-II which mainly includes construction of 4.60 km long flyover along with the service roads on the ground.
- 3. EFEC, further, informed that during the Review Meeting taken by Ministry in Goa from 11.06.2018 to 13.06.2018 it was appraised that despite the 2<sup>nd</sup> call, single bid was received and the reason could be the qualification criteria in respect of experience in construction of single work of bridge 80 m span as per MoRTH circular. It was decided in the meeting that, NHIDCL may examined the qualification criteria and the same may be relaxed so that sufficient response is obtained.
- 4. The Committee after due deliberation recommended that, the quoted price of 13.038% above the amount put to tender is on higher side and may not be accepted, annul the bidding process and invite fresh bids in accordance with clause 3.3.3 of RFP after examining/relaxing the qualification criteria as discussed during the review meeting at Goa.

Meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the chair.
