With esteemed regards and reverence, I want to submit that the Restoration & Periodical Repairs by way of clearance of landslides, surface boulders, side drain and culverts including construction of R/walls and B/walls and laying of Bituminous Carpeting of NH 244, on Chatroo-Sinthanpass-Anantnag Khanabal road from km 138.00 to km 193.00 and 193.00 to 242.00 in the UT of J&K. Both the works are around 12 crores each but unfortunately you have not kept the completion certificate of PMGSY department, Ministry of Roads and Surface department is also funding to PMGSY department like same way as to NHIDCL and specifications are almost the same. Recently NHIDCL department has laid the Bituminous carpet on Chatroo to Singhpora roads and we found that specification are almost the same. It is mere small works than how come the contractor like us will get qualify for this type of works. Moreover, BRO, GREF, R&B, PWD are accepting PMGSY completion certificate but unfortunately you have not kept that in your RFP. In this regards your goodself is requested kindly amend the RFP and add the PMGSY department completion certificate as well, as NHIDCL was setup in the year 2014 than how come PMGSY or RNB contractors have qualified in NHIDCL works. In Srinagar area there were hardly any contractors having any NHIDCL completion but at present with the help of PMGSY they are having worth crores of completion certificate from NHIDCL. It seems conspiracy in giving benefit to few contractors that's why you have not kept PMGSY or RNB completion certificate in your RFP. You are humbly requested to change the RFP and allow small contractors to participate in the said bidding process.	As per RFP.
2.	As per the rule in RFP you have to keep the last 5 years record but you have kept only 2022-23 work done for completion certificate, so kindly go through the rule laid by the Government of India for the same and necessary changes be made at an earliest.	As per clause 4.3 of Section-II of RFP, the bidders are required to provide average annual financial turnover and similar works for the last 5 (five) years, considering the base year as 2022-23.
