

National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd.

Subject: Construction and Upgradation including specialized slope treatment of existing road to 2-lane with paved shoulder from existing km. 458.900 to km. 459.475 (design ch 456.200 to ch 456.800) of Patalganga landslide of nh-07 under Chardham Pariyojna on EPC basis in the state of Uttarakhand. (design length = 0.600 km) -Minutes of 2nd Meeting of Empowered Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (ETEC) held on 29.11.2018.

The RFPs for the subject work were invited with Bid Due Date as 30.10.2018 till 1500 hrs.

2. Having opened the Technical Bids on 31.10.2018 received from the following four applicants in the presence of representatives of applicants, who choose to attend the RFPs opening, Hard copies of the original documents along with the soft copy (as received from CPP portal) were handed over to the concerned Financial Consultant, **M/s Raj Har Gopal & Co.** for carrying out the evaluation of the Technical Bids:

4. In the preliminary Evaluation Report dated 06.11.2018 (Annexure-I), the Financial Consultant recommended to seek clarifications from all four bidders viz. **M/s Bharat Construction., M/s KCC Buildcon Pvt. Ltd., M/s Backbone Construction Pvt. Ltd. and M/s Nagyan Construction Pvt. Ltd.** to consolidate the



evaluation. Accordingly, the queries were raised with the respective bidders; their replies have since been received and handed over to Financial Consultant. The Financial Consultant, M/s Raj Har Gopal & Co. has submitted the Final Evaluation Report on 27.11.2018 (Annexure-II), in the Evaluation Report, the detail of Technical and Financial Capacity and the Bid Capacity of the all four bidders as per the report including the final outcome is as under:

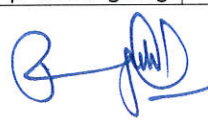

It is also added here that Power of Attorney (Appendix III) was also signed on 25.10.2018 along with Appendix IA & IB but due to some unavoidable circumstances, documents were notarized on 26.10.2018. Whereas, the 'General Power of Attorney' and 'Resolution' being the charter documents are prior to the signing of the bid documents. 3.	Value of B - Bidder has submitted the Statement showing value of all existing commitments and ongoing works verified by Statutory Auditor in respect of the Value of 'B'. However Certificates for all the projects mentioned in table for value of B for amount of work completed duly signed by the Client or its Engineer-in-charge not below the rank of Executive Engineer is not found in the submitted bid. In the absence of client certificates, value of B is considered as the value of award (worst scenario). Further, in last four projects i.e. from point 8 to 11, bidder stated that appointed date is yet to be decided. Bidder has applied factor of 1.05 for these four projects. Therefore the project has been assumed to be started in the FY 2016-17 (worst scenario) and value of B is considered accordingly for these four projects. Based on the above facts Bid capacity of the Bidder works out to be Rs 58.80 cr. (worst scenario) which is more than the required Bid capacity, therefore Bidder is considered as technically responsive subject to compliance of point 1 above.	In response to point No.1(c) of the referred letter, it is to inform you that, we have not submitted the ongoing work certificates from the concerned authorities for authentication of work done of ongoing works because due to unavoidable reasons beyond our control such as non-availability of the concerned authorities due to their other engagements/meetings, non-processing of submitted work done bills due to which not getting actual work done certificate at the time of submission of bid etc. but we have shown the actual amount of work executed in each project which can be verified from the concerned authorities if required. However, in the meantime we again follow up with the concerned authorities to get the said certificates and only two certificates of Sl. No. 1 & Sl. No. 2 works are received by us and are submitting herewith for your kind information and necessary action. We have not received 'ongoing work certificates' of Sl. No. 6 and Sl. No. 7 till date facing the same complication as mentioned above i.e. non-availability of concerned authority and therefore submitting the copy of work done bill of the said works as a proof for your consideration. In response to point No.1(d) of the referred letter, it is to inform you that we are submitting the obtained ongoing work certificates/copy of work done bills and request you to kindly re-calculate our Bid Capacity which fulfils the requirement. In response to point No.1(e) of the referred letter, it is to inform you that we are submitting the 'Calculation of Bid Capacity' and hope it fulfils the required criteria. The work at Sl. No. 8, 9, 10 & 11 whose appointed date have not been given by the concerned authorities due to non-availability of requisite clearances hence it is submitted that the value of these works may please be executed while computing the Bid Capacity. 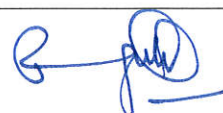
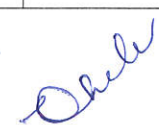

Further, Auditors report, Director Report, Cash Flow Statement and Notes to Accounts are not found in the audited annual reports submitted. Audited Annual report for the year 2017-18 or 2012-13 is not found in the submitted bid. Also undertaking from the statutory auditor for 2017-18 is not found in the submitted bid. Above all, In Annex II & IV submitted, Bidder has claimed only single project of Rs. 17.59 cr., however as per RFP, Bidder shall, over the past 5 (five) financial years preceding the Bid Due Date, have received payments for construction of Eligible Project(s), or has undertaken construction works by itself in a PPP project, such that the sum total thereof is more than Rs. 41.83 crore (Rupees forty one crore eighty three lakh only) (the “Threshold Technical Capacity”). (Also in formats submitted for Annex II & IV “refer clause 2.2.2.2, 2.2.2.5 & 2.2.2.7 of RFP” is mentioned) Based on above fact, as the Bidder is not meeting the Technical capacity criteria as per clause 2.2.2.2 of RFP, therefore Bid submitted by the Bidder i.e. Backbone Construction Private Limited, is considered as technically non responsive for next stage i.e. opening of Financial Bid. The additional four projects submitted after submission of Bid cannot be considered being additional in nature and has direct/ material impact on the Bid submitted by the Bidder at the time of Bid submission. Previously submitted list of five out of six projects whose Annex II & IV available now are checked to find if the Bidder is qualifying the criteria on the basis of original submission. It has been observed that none of the projects claimed are meeting the criteria of 2.2.2.2 (ii) i.e. “Provided that at least one similar work of 25% of Estimated Project Cost (10.46 cr.) shall have been completed from the Eligible Projects in Category 1 and/or Category 3 specified in Clause 2.2.2.5”. Above all, new projects submitted now are also not meeting the criteria as per clause 2.2.2.2 (ii) of RFP. Based on the above facts, Bidder is not qualifying the criteria of Threshold Technical Capacity as per clause 2.2.2.2 (i) and 2.2.2.2 (ii). Therefore Bidder is considered as Non - Responsive.
