2. The Committee met on 25.09.2020 to finalize the 1<sup>st</sup> stage evaluation (MOM attached). Following 03 (three) firms were qualified for Second Stage of Technical Bid Evaluation:

4. (a) As per clause 3.2.4 (ii) and clause 5.2 of Letter of Invitation (LoI) of RFP, "The technical proposal should score at least 75 points out of 100 to be considered for financial evaluation. The CV of the proposed Team Leader should score at least 75 % marks otherwise the entire proposal shall be considered to have failed in the evaluation of Technical Proposals and shall not be considered for opening of Financial Proposals." As per above table in para 3.3, CV of Team Leader cum Senior Tunnel Expert scores less than 75% marks, hence the entire proposal of firm is to be considered failed in the evaluation of Technical Proposals and accordingly the bidder M/s. L. N. Malviya Infra Projects Pvt. Ltd. in association with Highway Engineering Consultant is not eligible for next stage of evaluation i.e. Stage-III: Evaluation of Financial Proposal.

(b) As per clause 3.2.4 (ii) of Letter of Invitation (LoI) of RFP, "CV of a person who does not meet the minimum experience requirement as given at enclosure-II of TOR shall be evaluated and the marks obtained shall be taken into consideration during evaluation of Technical Proposal (except Team leader). However if a firm with such key personnel is declared the "most preferred bidder" for a particular package, such key personnel should be replaced before signing of contract with a person meeting requirements of Qualification and Experience as given at enclosure-II of TOR and whose CV secures 75 % marks and above." As per above table in para 3.3, CV of Senior Geotechnical Engineer of both the eligible firms (M/s. CM Engineering & Solution in JV with Anandjiwala Infra Advisory in association with Anandjiwala Technical Consultancy and M/s. Intercontinental Consultants and Technocrats Pvt. Ltd.) does not meet the minimum experience requirement and scores less than 75% marks, hence such key personnel is to be replaced before signing of contract.

5. The final technical scores of the firms w. r. t. above mentioned three criteria of technical evaluation are mentioned as under:

- ii) Financial Bids may be opened subsequently with the approval of the Competent Authority.

6. TEC noted that as per clause 1.8.5 of Letter of Invitation (LoI) of RFP, ***“Only Indian firms are allowed to participate in the bid and no International Bidder is eligible as individually or as a member of a Joint Venture or as an associate. However the firms may propose foreign nationals (maximum 02 Nos.) as key personnel”***. Hence, the firm M/s. Casta Engineers Pvt. Ltd. in JV with Hexa Co. in association with Nokang Infra Pvt. Ltd. is not eligible to participate in the bid as the JV member of the firm is not Indian and accordingly, the firm may be declared as ***‘Non Responsive’***.
